Day One: Isaiah 9:2-3, 6-7. In what ways have you experienced these characteristics of Jesus in your own life? How do these truths about God affect your response while living in a world in need of hope?

Day Two: John 10:22-36. What are the characteristics of Jesus listed here that bring hope? How do these traits encourage you or strengthen you in your faith?

Day Three: Ezekiel 34:11-16. What do these verses remind us about the heart of God? In what areas of your life do you need to experience the love and comfort of Jesus?

Day Four: John 8:12. Take time today to reflect on this one verse. How has the light of Jesus brought you life? In what ways is the light of Jesus exposing the darkness in your life and transforming you into a new creation?

Day Five: Read Luke 2:25-32 in preparation for next week's message. How do these verses encourage or challenge you? In what ways have you experienced the peace of Jesus? How has this peace changed the way you respond to difficulties?
